EDP & NYCS News Announcement

To: EDP North Atlantic teams/clubs

As the Fall 2022 season starts to wind down, we want to review the season and, also, look ahead to the Spring 2023 season as well as the 2023/2024 seasonal year.

By the end of the week, you will receive an invitation to a virtual “town hall” meeting during which we will share information and answer your questions.

Some quick updates:

- The Fall 2022 North Atlantic Conference season has gone well for the 13U and 14U age groups. These age groups will again compete in Conference play during Spring 2023. With promotion and relegation between Premier I and Premier II based on Fall 2022 on the field performance occurring before the Spring 2023 season, the Spring season should be even more competitive for all teams.
- As usual, for the older age groups (15U, 16U, 17U, 18U, 19U), the Fall season has been reserved for high school play. North Atlantic Conference play will, again, occur during Spring 2023. The deadline to apply for these age groups is December 1st. Acceptances and brackets will be announced shortly after that.
- Winners of the North Atlantic Conference Premier I Spring 2023 season (13U through 19U) will have the opportunity to qualify for the 2023 USYS Eastern Regional Championships and will qualify for the 2023/2024 USYS National League P.R.O. (19U Spring 2023 teams excluded).
- Although it’s early, as you turn to planning for 2023/2024, it is important for you to know that the process for selecting teams and clubs to compete in the North Atlantic Conference (Premier I and Premier II) will remain unchanged. Once again, teams and clubs from ENYYSA member leagues and EDP North Atlantic can apply and be evaluated for selection to compete in the North Atlantic Conference. ENYYSA is introducing its own league in Spring 2023. Teams from this league can also apply and be evaluated to earn a place in the Conference structure. If you are satisfied with how the process has worked for your teams and club, you do not need to change your league affiliation.

We look forward to you joining us for the virtual “town hall.”
